

Yes, hiring a kayak these days is a bit like hiring a car: your identity is linked to the number plate of the kayak for the duration of the activity, in order to avoid fines, it is best to respect the navigation code.

Please note that if you have booked for a group, from that moment on you become responsible for the participants and for all the kayaks used.

1. What does this mean?

When you board, your identity will be scanned and linked to the kayak(s) hired. Each kayak has a number visible at the tip, and it is essential that you keep the same kayak(s) throughout your trip.

Numerous checks are carried out on the river by the Police and sworn agents from the Nature and Forests Division (DNF). In case of an offence, the kayak number will be noted. The Pro-Justitia and the payment order will be sent by post directly to your home address (from \leq 50 to \leq 1250).

As this penalty is issued directly by the authorities, it can only be contested before them and SA Dinant Evasion cannot be held responsible under any circumstances.

2. What type of offence? -

PROHIBITIONS







- Boarding the kayaks with a cool box, barbecue equipment, beer crates/packs or bottles of alcohol. Anything you take with you must fit in the bucket supplied with the kayak.
- Throwing your rubbish out.
 Garbage buckets are available at boarding.
- Docking at an unauthorised areas; no sign = no stop.
- Making fires.
- Disturbing nature and animals.
- Use a sound amplifier (loudspeaker/boom-box/mobile phone/ etc.).

OBLIGATIONS







- Respecting other river users, including anglers and residents
- And for those who have chosen the 12 or the 21km trip: passing through the second dam before 6pm (5pm before 15/06)*.



3. If you do not wish to take responsibility for part of the group/the whole group:

Please contact us to adapt the booking to the number of participants you agree to supervise, or ask someone who accepts this responsibility to contact us, so that they can pass on their details.

4. 1 booking = 1 payment

It is not possible to pay separately at the ticket office for the same booking. If you wish to make separate payments, you must also modify the booking (see point 3).

5. If you decide to cancel and come without a reservation

Identification of kayakers is compulsory and systematic. If you do not book in advance, identification will have to be carried out on site in any case, which will considerably lengthen the waiting time at the ticket desks.
